Profile title: A short, catchy title to grab the reader’s interest

Name: Salutation (Dr., Mr., Ms., etc.), your first name and last name

Institution: Your primary affiliation (typically a university)

Current position: (e.g., senior scientist, associate professor)

Main text

Maximum 150 words

In the first person (I or we), describe the impact of your CIHR-funded research. Have you discovered a new use for a medication? Come up with a new screening method for a common condition? How has your research contributed to making Canadians healthier?

Further reading: Include links to your website (or related websites) that would be of interest to the reader

Twitter handle: Add your personal, university or organization handle so we can tag you.

Plain language: We ask that you please avoid jargon and keep it simple.

Share: Once we edit, translate and post your story, we’ll send you the link and then you can also share and promote it on your platforms and website as well.

Photo: Please attach a photo of your research in action. A photo of you in the lab or working at the hospital, or a group photo of your research team, for example.
